## 2014-15 PROGRAM GUIDELINES

## **Purpose:**

The purpose of the ePrize Technology Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to college students while connecting them to the ePrize brand and potential internship and employment opportunities.

#### **Amount of Award:**

The value of the scholarship is \$5,000. A total of two (2) scholarships will be awarded for the 2014-15 academic year.

## **Applicant eligibility:**

- U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Junior or senior status for academic year 2014-15
- Minimum cumulative 3.0 grade point average (on a 4.0 scale)
- Full-time undergraduate student majoring in one of the following areas;
  - o Computer Science
  - o Computer Information Systems

#### **Application and Selection Process:**

- Applicants will be required to complete an application including an essay (maximum one page) outlining their personal and academic background. Applications must be typed and submitted to MCF in Microsoft Word or PDF format.
- Completed applications must be submitted by 5:00 PM on Monday, January 20, 2014 to your campus financial aid office.
- Applicants will be required to conduct an in–person interview with the ePrize Talent Team.
  Interviews will be concluded by February 10, 2014 (tentative).
- MCF will coordinate notification to the scholarship recipients through the financial aid offices by February 24, 2014 (tentative).
- Scholarship funds will be distributed to the colleges by June 30, 2014.
